

## **K-W Granite Club Registration Policy**

Since most of our leagues are currently at capacity, the Board of Directors will once again use the registration policy that has been used the past two years in order to ensure that members from the 2008/2009 season are able secure a spot in their league.

- Early Membership registration date of up to and including September 2<sup>nd</sup> of each year
  - Registered means a signed form AND paid in full or signed up for instalments.
  - Preference given to returning members signing up for the SAME night/league as they played last year.
    - Registration secures a spot on that night/league in the Individuals section
      - Date is still a factor; the sooner you register the sooner you secure a spot.
    - Team Entries – requires 3 paid members (at least 2 previously in that night/league)
    - This moves the individuals up into the Team section (with 1 TBD or blank)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> choice given to returning members signing up for a new night.
    - After Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> and after all returning members who have previous played on that night/league have been processed (either slotted into Individual or Team sections) then returning members selecting a new night are slotted into the Individual or Team section. If the night/league reaches capacity then the person is put on a WAIT list (based on date)
- As of Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> – spots will be secured first come first serve registration (based on date not date & time)
  - If someone was listed as part of someone else's team entry and has not registered/paid they are removed IF there is someone on the WAIT list for that night/leagues (would either be returning member opting for a new night or a new member).
- If the above protocol does not determine/resolve issues – then a lottery/pick from hat administered by VP Curling (ie more registrations received the same day than spots to fill – then lottery/pick from hat of all same dated registration to consume the spots for the night/league will be conducted)
