

K-W GRANITE CLUB LADIES CURLING

RULES FOR THE DAY LADIES CHAMPIONSHIP

1. The Competition will run as a Round Robin with playoffs.
2. The Round Robin shall be scored as scores and number of ends in order to determine the top eight teams for playoffs. If a game is forfeited, the remaining end will go to the winning team. Scores shall be marked to a total of eight ends.
3. Games will be 8 ends. A tie will be broken by an extra end towards the glass. There is no time limit on a game, but a reasonable pace is expected.
4. If a team is 15 minutes late, the end is forfeited. The opposing team scores one point, and has last rock.
5. The four original team members may change position for any game after the season starts.
6. If a team goes on the ice with 3 players, the lead and second play 3 stones each.
7. All teams must have at least 2 regular players. Skips knowing in advance that they cannot have a legal game, must attempt to arrange with opposing skip to play the game at other than the scheduled date. PLEASE - NO DEFAULTS.
8. All re-scheduled games must be played by the last scheduled game of the Round Robin.
9. There will be 4 prizes awarded - Trophy winner and second place.
- Consolation winner and second consolation
10. **PLAY-OFFS**
 - A) At the end of scheduled play, the top 4 teams will play to determine a first place winning team and a second place runner-up team. The next 4 teams will play for consolation winner and second consolation.
 - Game #1
 - a) Team 1 plays team 4
 - b) Team 2 plays team 3
 - c) Team 5 plays team 8
 - d) Team 6 plays team 7
 - Game #2
 - a) Winner of #1a) plays winner of #1b) to determine 1st & 2nd place
 - b) Winner of #1c) plays winner of #1d) to determine consolation winners
 - B) TIES – if ties result for positioning after regular play, our tie breaking rules will apply
 - C) SPARES FOR PLAYOFFS
 - 1) Every effort should be made to have the original teams for playoffs, even if a reschedule is required. Any spare must play in at least one Day Ladies League event.
11. The Four Rock Rule is in effect
12. A practice as the beginning of the curling season will be scheduled if time allows.
